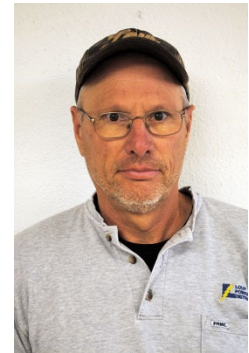

Dave Meyer marks 45 years at Loup Power

COLUMBUS, Neb. — Dave Meyer of Albion was recently recognized for 45 years of service to Loup Power District.

Meyer serves as Line Foreman for the Albion line crew. His duties include heading up the line crew in charge of construction and maintenance of Loup's electrical transmission and distribution system in the Albion Division.

Meyer joined Loup in 1976 as an Apprentice Lineman at Albion. He was promoted to Lineman in 1977 and to Journeyman Lineman in 1980. He transferred to Journeyman Lineman/Serviceman in 1984 and became Journeyman Lineman at the Albion Retail Operation in 1986.



In 1995, Meyer transferred to the Columbus Retail Operation and was promoted to Line Foreman at Fullerton in 2001. He transferred to the Albion Retail Operation as a Journeyman Lineman in 2005 before being named Line Foreman for the Albion line crew in 2014.

Meyer is a graduate of Sheldon High School in Sheldon, Iowa. He attended Northwest Iowa Technical College in Sheldon, Iowa, where he earned a degree in Utility Line.

He has three children — Patrick, Amy, and Shannon.
