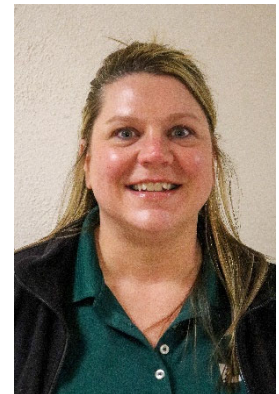
Cromwell Promoted to Customer Billing Coordinator
