

# RATE SCHEDULE LH

## — Loup Space Heating Service — LOUP RIVER PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT

### **AVAILABLE**

Within the service area of the District. After January 1, 1992, this rate is only available for customers on the rate as of December 31, 1991.

### **APPLICABLE**

To any customer for electric space heating where service is supplied through a separate meter and circuit to which no equipment may be connected, except the space heating units and the water heating unit of an electric hot water heater. (Air conditioning — See Condition 4.)

### **CHARACTER OF SERVICE**

A.C. 60 Hertz, single- or three-phase, at any of the District's standard voltages.

### **COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL RATE**

Customer Service Charge: \$25.00 per month

Summer	Winter	
\$0.1120	\$0.0975	per kilowatt-hour for all use.

### **MINIMUM BILL**

The customer service charge.

### **SEASONAL BILLING PERIODS**

**Summer:** Summer period is for the meter readings obtained during the four-month period from June 15 through October 14.

**Winter:** Winter period is for the meter readings obtained during the eight-month period from October 15 through June 14.

### **PRODUCTION COST ADJUSTMENT (PCA)**

The kilowatt-hours supplied under this rate schedule are subject to the PCA. The PCA is an adjustment in the price of the energy portion of the rate due to variations in the cost of procuring or producing energy from those costs that are included in the rate schedules.

### **TERMS OF PAYMENT**

Bills are due and payable upon receipt and delinquent if not paid in twenty-one (21) days from date of issuance.

**CONDITIONS**

1. Service will be furnished under the District's Customer Service Policy.
2. The minimum amount of space heat which can be connected under this schedule is four (4) kilowatts.
3. This schedule is not to be used to serve electric hot water heaters without a minimum of four (4) kilowatts of space heating connected.
4. Air conditioning units which cool the identical area to be heated may be connected to the electric space heating circuit.
5. In the case of equipment having abnormally low annual load factors or unusual operating characteristics, special minimum charges may be established by the District.
