RATE SCHEDULE LMM-RIDER

Loup Miscellaneous Municipal Service Rider

LOUP RIVER PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT

AVAILABLE

Within the service area of the District.

APPLICABLE

To communities, counties, public school districts, education service units, fairgrounds or county agricultural societies, airport authorities and other non-profit entities which are supported directly from local taxes and served under the following schedules:

General Service: LG-1

Large Light & Power Service: LP, LP-1, LP-3

The test for determining whether or not an account should be billed under the provisions of this schedule is as follows: The service must be provided to, billed to, and paid by a community, county, public education district or non-profit entity which is locally tax supported. Local taxes are considered those tax funds from communities or counties. State, federal and profit operating entities would not be eligible for the municipal rider discount.

RATE

The rates and charges for electric service regularly applicable under the rate schedules listed above except that the provisions under the minimum bill associated with installed transformer capacity shall not apply for loads that normally operate only between 7 p.m. and 8 a.m.

Customers served under this schedule shall be allowed to disconnect and reconnect seasonal loads by paying the disconnect and reconnect charges and will not be subject to the provisions in the second paragraph of Section 6 of the Customer Service Policy.

DISCOUNT

A 331/3 percent discount shall apply to:

- 1. The energy billing as computed under the rate schedules applicable to General Service, and
- 2. The energy billing only as computed under rate schedules applicable to Large Light and Power Service.

The net billing under the LMM-Rider for any billing period shall not be less than an amount equal to \$ 0.1080 per kilowatt-hour during the summer months and \$0.0910 per kilowatt-hour during the winter months multiplied by the number of kilowatt-hours during any billing period for those served under the LG-1 rate schedule. The net billing under the LMM-Rider for any billing period shall not be less than an amount equal to \$0.0800 per kilowatt-hour during the summer months and \$ 0.0650 per kilowatt-hour during the winter months multiplied by the number of kilowatt-hours during any billing period for those served under the LP, LP-1, or LP-3 rate schedules.

In no event will the 33¹/₃ percent discount apply to the minimum bill. No customer will be billed more than the charges under the applicable rate.

MINIMUM BILL

The monthly minimum bill as provided in the applicable rate schedule.

CONDITIONS

Service will be furnished under the District's Customer Service Policy and conditions as provided in contracts for service under this schedule.
