Alt Promoted to Engineering Technician

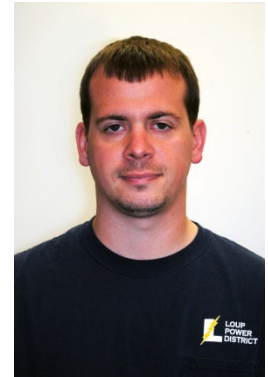
COLUMBUS, Neb. —Aric Alt has been promoted to Engineering Technician at Loup Power District.
