COLUMBUS, Neb. — Line Foreman Stan Wielgus has retired from Loup Power District after more than 38 years of service.

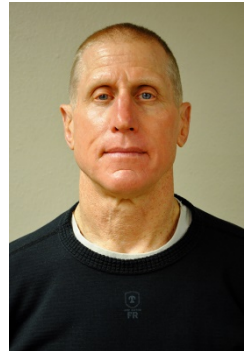
