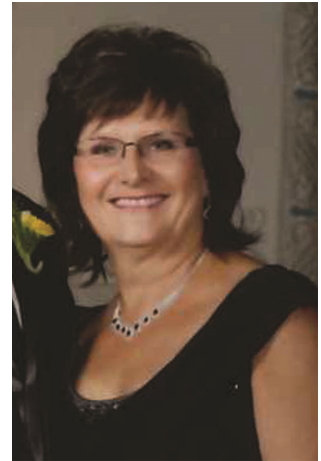
Petsche Joins Loup Power District
