Bridger Retires from Loup Power District

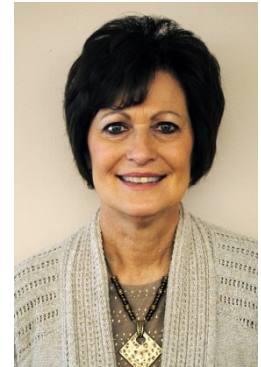
COLUMBUS, Neb. — Janice Bridger of Fullerton has retired from Loup Power District after more than 28 years of service.
