# Scam alert: Utility scammers targeting area

**COLUMBUS, Neb.** — Several customers of Loup Power District and Nebraska Public Power District have reported scam calls. The callers threaten electrical service disconnection within 30 minutes if they are not paid with cash or prepaid cards.

Remember that Loup Power District does not conduct business in this manner. If you receive such a call, hang up and call your local Loup Power District office. Do not give the caller any personal information.
